# National Emergency Grant

*Did you work for a financial services company?  
Was your job eliminated or were you laid off?*

The National Emergency Grant (NEG) is designed to provide career counseling and training services to help you get a job or change careers.

Only individuals who have been laid off from a specific list of financial services companies are eligible to receive NEG benefits.

### *How can the NEG Program help you?*

- Allows you to change careers or industries

### *Are you eligible?*

- Your former employer must be on the list of financial services companies eligible to receive NEG benefits
- Anyone laid off from these companies after March 2008 is eligible
- You can be currently employed or unemployed and still receive NEG benefits
- You can either live or work in Connecticut
